The IUC Records Retention schedule, a standardized records management tool that has been adopted and adapted by all IUC-member universities, has been housed at OSU Archives since 1992. However, big changes, which will revolutionize the way in which institutions develop, manage and produce retention schedules, are coming! Pari Swift, OSU University Records Manager, will give an overview of the new Zasio Versatile Retention Software program that OSU and IUC members will implement this year, which will greatly enhance the current retention schedule. Many value-add features will be available to address institutional compliance needs such as public records management, privacy, e-discovery, and cyber security all of which will serve to increase operational efficiencies.
